PROJECT NAME: HALF CIRCLE SKIRT

FINISHED SIZE: 31" X 18"

COLLECTION: LINEN BLEND SOLIDS

This project is based on a 57" WOF from our Linen Blend fabrics.



FABRIC A
DENL4004
ASHEN

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

- Fusible Interfacing (Waistband and front buttons band.)
- 7 (Seven) Buttons.

*¼" seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.*

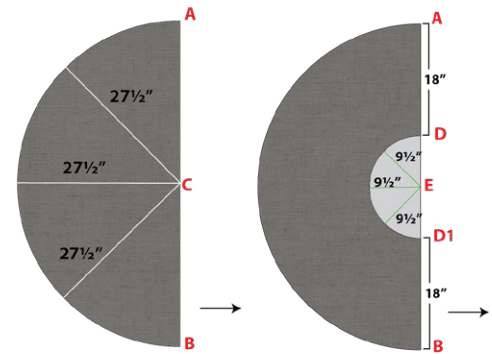
FABRIC A:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip (Waistband)

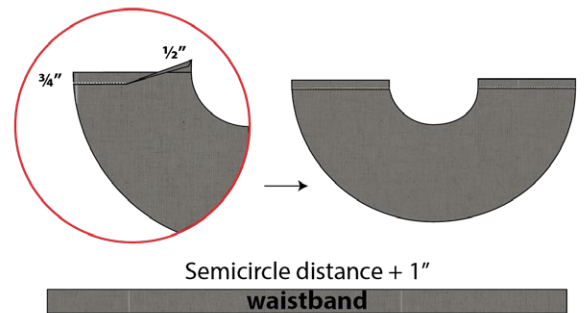
Sew all rights sides together with ½" seam allowance.

- With your yard open, trace a line from **A** to **B** that measures 55".
- Mark a point **C** in the center from **A** to **B**.
- Trace a half circle using 27½" guide.
- Mark a point **D** from **A** that measures 18".
- Mark a point **D1** from **B** that measures 18".

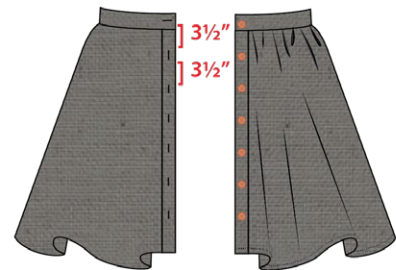
- Mark a point **E** in the center of **D-D1**.
- Trace half circle from point **E** using 9½" guide.
- Cut the (**D-E-D1**) semicircle from **ACB** semicircle.



- Fold ½" then ¾" each end to clean the front of your circle skirt.
- Measure the inner semicircle distance and use this number to trim your waist band + 1"



- Sew your waistband to the skirt body, leave ½" off on both ends to finish it clean.
- Fold ½" twice to clean the hem.
- Mark buttons placement every 3½", make button holes and sew your buttons.



- For larger sizes, cut 2 (two) semicircles and sew them together, this will make the skirt very flouncy and it will be more size adjustable.
