## **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

- Fusible Interfacing (Waistband and front buttons band.
- 7 (Seven) Buttons.

1/4" seam allowances are included. WOF means width of fabric.


## FABRIC A:

• (1) 3" x WOF strip (Waistband)


Sew all rights sides together with  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance.

- With your yard open, trace a line from A to B that measures 55".
- Mark a point C in the center from A to B.
- Trace a half circle using 27½" guide.
- Mark a point D from A that measures 18".
- Mark a point D1 from B that measures 18".

- Mark a point E in the center of D-D1.
- Trace half circle from point E using 9½" guide.
- Cut the (D-E-D1) semicircle from ACB semicircle.



- Fold ½" then ¾" each end to clean the front of your circle skirt.
- Measure the inner semicircle distance and use this number to trim your waist band + 1"



- Sew your waistband to the skirt body, leave ½"off on both ends to finish it clean.
- Fold ½" twice to clean the hem.
- Mark buttons placement every 3½", make button holes and sew your buttons.



• For larger sizes, cut 2 (two) semicircles and sew them together, this will make the skirt very flouncy and it will be more size adjustable.
