

# SEW QUICK

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

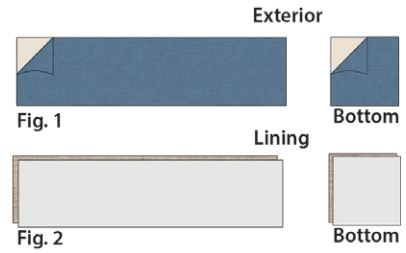
- Align (1) 17" x 5" strip and (1) 5" square from fabric **A** to a piece of batting and quilt it, then trim (1) piece to  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " and the other piece to a  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square. (Exterior).
- Place interfacing on the wrong side of (1)  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip and (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square from fabric **B**, and iron (fig. 2). (Lining).



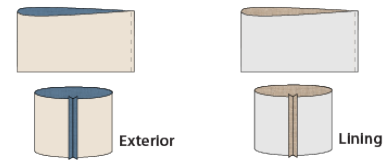
PROJECT NAME: FABRIC BASKETS

FINISHED SIZE: 4" x 4" - 8" x 4"

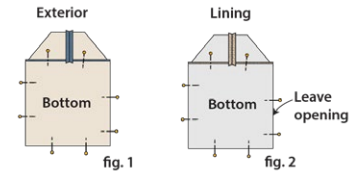
COLLECTION: LINEN BLEND SOLIDS



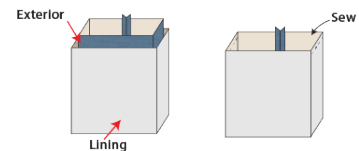
- Sew the short edges of the exterior piece and do the same with the lining piece.



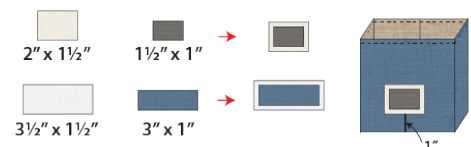
- Pin the exterior piece to the edges of the square with right sides facing and sew. (fig. 1).
- Pin the lining piece to the edges of the square, right sides facing together, leave an opening big enough to turn the basket inside out. (fig. 2)



- Insert the exterior basket inside of the lining basket right sides of fabric facing together, align and secure it with pins and sew all the way around.
- Use the lining opening to turn the basket inside out and handstitch it to close it. Top stitch.
- Repeat the previous steps from the basket A for baskets B & C.



- To make the labels you can use two rectangles of the fabric of your choice and steam a seam to iron it to each basket.

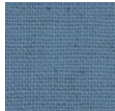

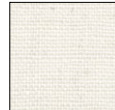

$\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances are included.  
WOF means width of fabric.

## BASKETS A & B

### FABRIC A

- (1) 5" square.
- (1) 17" x 5" strip.

### FABRIC B

- (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
- (1)  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

### INTERFACING

- (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
- (1)  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

## BASKET C

### FABRIC A

- (1) 9" x 5" rectangle.
- (1) 25" x 5" strip.

### FABRIC B

- (1)  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.
- (1)  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

### INTERFACING

- (1)  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.
- (1)  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.



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
